Michael (Mike) Sweeney leads Westinghouse Electric Company's Legal and Compliance organization. In this role, he is responsible for overseeing all legal and compliance operations of the global business activities. He has served as General Counsel since August 2011.

Mr. Sweeney joined Westinghouse in 2005 as an Assistant General Counsel for Nuclear Services. Beginning in 2006, Mr. Sweeney gained increasing responsibility within the legal organization and in 2010, was named Vice President and Deputy General Counsel.

His primary focus was on corporate and business matters where he counseled companies on various legal matters including financing operations, strategic initiatives and general corporate matters. In addition, from 1989 to 2000, Mr. Sweeney held positions of increasing responsibility in the Law Department of CBS Corporation (formerly Westinghouse Electric Corporation). His primary focus was on Corporate Governance matters, Securities and Exchange Commission filing requirements for public companies as well as acquisitions and divestitures.
